# 2020 ARCHBISHOP'S INVITATIONAL ART EXHIBIT



Artwork developed by students for the Archbishop's Invitational Art Exhibit should reflect their interpretation of the annual theme:

**"Enflame Our Hearts - "**

## ART EXHIBIT GUIDELINES

High school students currently enrolled at any of the Catholic high schools located within the geographic boundaries of the Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas are invited to submit their artwork to their art teacher. The faculty will submit the student's artwork that meets the high standards desired for the Archbishop's Invitational Catholic High School Art Exhibit.

- Artwork that is selected by the high school faculty is due to the Office of Catholic Schools in preparation for the display **no later than February 17, 2020.**
- **A public exhibit will begin on March 6, 2019;** judging will occur between **February 24, 2019 and February 26, 2020.**
- Award Reception will be **March 6.**
- A maximum of 10 student works may be submitted by schools. (More than one item may be submitted per student, but a maximum of ten works are to be accepted from each high school.)
- If appropriate, attach a hanging wire to the back of the piece in order to allow for easy installation.
- Dimensions of the artworks are limited to no more than 36 inches in height or width.
- Artwork must remain until the close of the exhibit. All artwork must be picked up between noon and 5 p.m. on the end day at the Savior Pastoral Center.

Students and/or teachers must submit a request for any exceptions to this rule that may occur due to advance placement portfolio reviews or other special circumstances, prior to the opening of the exhibit.

Students may or may not agree to sell their artwork. An asking price, if applicable, needs to be clearly stated on the application information; the sale price is determined by the artist. The proceeds of any sale will be made payable to the student artist unless otherwise instructed by the artist. Sales of art are managed by the Savior Pastoral Center staff during business hours.

Judging will be done between February 24, 2019 and February 26, 2020 by the art exhibit committee of the Catholic Fine Arts Council and announced at the reception on March 6, 2020.

Only original artwork may be submitted for judging. Copies will be disqualified. Artwork that is copied, replicated or manipulated from published photographs, magazines or book illustrations or other artwork including the internet is not acceptable (collages and original digital art are acceptable.) If a photo is used, the original must be reviewed by the student's teacher and approved to authenticate originality.

## AWARD RECEPTION

The awards reception at 9:00 am on March 6, 2020 will honor the artists, winners, teachers, families and friends. All guests are encouraged to attend this free event.

## Student Registration

Teachers will receive a link to be shared with all participating students. Each student must complete an online registration form for each piece submitted.

## JUDGING AND AWARDS

Judging will be based on:

- » creativity (original thinking)
- » interpretation of the annual theme (artistic expression)
- » technique (demonstrates a student's competency in using the medium to achieve the desired outcome)

## Awards will be given as follows:

Archbishop's Choice - one award of \$100  
Superintendent's Choice - one award of \$100  
Judge's Choice Awards - five awards of \$100  
Popular Choice Award - one award of \$100
